

Privacy policy

describes the rules for processing information about you by us, including personal data and cookies, i.e., the so-called cookies.

1. General information: The following Privacy Policy sets out the rules for the processing and protecting personal data provided by Users.

2. The administrator of personal data collected via our website, www.clocklikeminds.com, hereinafter "Clocklike Minds or "Administrator," is Clocklike Minds spółka z o.o. St. Karola Dickensa 27/27 02-382 Warsaw. Registered under KRS number 0000699504 NIP: 7010735563

3. In the interests of the security of the data entrusted to us, we have developed internal procedures and recommendations to prevent the disclosure of data to unauthorized persons. We control their performance and constantly check their compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals about the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (general regulation on data protection) (Official Journal of the European Union No. 119, p. 1), from now on referred to as "GDPR" and the Act of May 10, 2018, on the protection of personal data (consolidated text, Journal of Laws of 2019, item 1781).

4. Personal Data is processed based on the consent expressed by the User and in cases where the law authorizes the Website Administrator to process personal data based on the law or to implement the contract concluded between the parties.

5. Clocklikeminds.com performs the functions of obtaining information about users and their behavior in the following way:

- by voluntarily entering them by the User;
- by collecting "cookies";
- by collecting tracking codes to enable marketing campaigns;
- by collecting codes enabling the analysis of data posted on the website

6. The clocklikeminds.com website collects information voluntarily provided by the user.

- Personal data: name, surname;
- Contact details: address, telephone number, and email address;
- Communication content: all communications, inquiries, statements, views, and opinions about us submitted by users or published through the website;
- Online identifiers, such as IP addresses, data from cookies, and other online identifiers;

7. The data provided by the User is processed for the purpose resulting from the function of a specific form, e.g., to process the information contact, perform the contract by purchasing a product in the online store, or for marketing purposes.

8. Personal data left on the site will not be sold. The administrator reserves the right to share and process your data with the following recipients:

- About business partners who support us in running our business, such as:
 - technical service providers to whom we entrust the provision of IT systems, software, and hosting of our website;
 - companies providing services in the field of marketing communication and advertising;
 - companies that offer email, text, and postal services on our behalf,
 - our advisors, including lawyers, accountants, and auditors who provide professional services to us,
- about authorities if we are required to disclose your personal data to comply with any legal provisions.

9. The data made available to the Clocklike Minds brand may be viewed by the natural person who placed it there. This person also has the right to modify and stop processing their data at anytime.

10. Remember that in connection with the processing of your data, you have the right to:

- request us to access the data we hold about you;
- to rectify your data;
- to delete your data if they are no longer needed for the purposes for which they were processed or we have no other legal basis for their processing;
- to withdraw consent to the processing of your personal data in connection with the subscription to the newsletter;
- restrictions on data processing;
- to complain to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if you believe that your data is processed by us unlawfully.

11. We reserve the right to change the website's privacy policy, which may be affected by the development of Internet technology, possible changes in the law on the protection of personal data, and the development of our website. We will inform you about any changes visibly and understandably.

12. The website may contain links to other websites. Such websites operate independently of clocklikeminds.com and are not supervised by the Clocklike Minds brand in any way. These websites may have privacy policies and regulations, which we recommend you familiarize yourself with.

GDPR information clause

in the processing of personal data

1. The administrator of personal data is Clocklike Minds or the "Administrator" is Clocklike Minds spółka z o.o. st. Karola Dickensa 27/27 02-382 Warsaw. Registered under KRS number 0000699504 NIP: 7010735563
2. The personal data provided will be processed to provide services, handle requests and respond to requests on the website www.clocklikeminds.com
3. The categories of personal data include, among others: name and surname, telephone number, e-mail address, address, data dedicated to the process/service/project;
4. Your data may be transferred to entities processing personal data at the request of the administrator: IT service providers;
5. Your data will be stored for the duration of the legitimate interest of the administrator unless you object to data processing;
6. Your data will not be transferred to a third country or an international organization;
7. You have the right to access your data and the right to rectify, delete, and limit processing; the right to transfer data, the right to raise objections, the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing, which was made based on consent before its withdrawal;
8. You have the right to complain with the supervisory body dealing with the protection of personal data, which is the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, when you consider that the processing of your data violates the provisions of the Act of May 10 2018 on the protection of personal data (consolidated text Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1000) or the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27 2016 on the protection of individuals about the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and the repeal of Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) of April 27, 2016 (OJ L No. 119, p. 1);
9. The data provided by you will not be subject to automated decision-making and profiling;
10. The data comes from the data subjects;
11. Providing your data is voluntary;
